

Gary P. Taylor, MAI, SRA

Gary P. Taylor, MAI, SRA, served as president of the Appraisal Institute in 2004. He has served in a variety of education- and publication-related positions for the Appraisal Institute, including membership on the Curriculum Committee and the Advisory Committee for the Center for Advanced Real Estate Analysis. Previously he had chaired the Curriculum, Education and Faculty committees, and been a member of the Publications, Education Coordination and Education committees. Taylor was also a member of the Residential Appraisal Board from 1992-1995 and served as Long Island Chapter president in 1992, having served as its executive vice president in 1991.

For the American Institute of Real Estate Appraisers, Taylor was a member of the National Publications Committee. For the Society of Real Estate Appraisers, Taylor served as the vice president, secretary and treasurer for the executive board in three one-year stints, chaired the Advancement, Education and Bylaws committees and was the national chairman for courses and examinations.

In 1992, he received the William N. Kinnard Jr. Ph.D. award from the Education Trust of the Appraisal Institute for excellence in education and in 1997 received the *Real Estate Man of the Year Award* from the Long Island Chapter of the Appraisal Institute. He was the president of Rogers and Taylor Appraisers, Inc. An appraisal firm that employed 28 appraisers. In 2015 he was awarded the James H Pritchett Award for his significant contributions to appraisal education from the Appraisal Institute.

He served as Vice Chair of the Appraiser Qualifications Board from 2006-2007 and then a Chair from 2008-2010. Subsequently he served as Chair of the Appraisal Practices Board from January 2010-December 2012. He then served as Vice Chair of the Appraisers Qualifications Board from 2013-2015. In 2016 he was awarded the Chair's Public Service award by The appraisal Foundation.
